## Create aims to empower and equip teaching teams with the skills to:

- implement arts learning in their professional practice and daily pedagogy.
- o make connections in the arts with their everyday life.
- spark interest in the arts for early learners (3-K and Pre-K).

## Over the course of two years:

- 3-K and Pre-K teaching teams will spend one semester on each art form.
- Each semester will begin with a professional learning session followed by a coaching residency.
- Expert teaching artists will directly coach and mentor teaching teams in the arts with 4 coaching residency visits.
- The semester will culminate in a second professional learning session or Share Fair.

## As a result of Create professional learning, Pre-K and 3K teachers:

- Participate in high quality arts practices with expert teaching artists from 92<sup>nd</sup>
   Street Y, New Victory Theater, Third Street Music School, and Studio in a School.
- Engage in peer exchange, reflection, and collaboration for best practices in the arts and experiential learning.
